

Dr Harkishan Singh, a medicinal chemist and a pharmaceutical historian, has been Professor, Head and Dean, Pharmaceutical Sciences, at the Panjab University, Chandigarh. Earlier he was on the faculties of the Banaras Hindu University, and the University of Saugar. He has spent several years abroad working at the Universities of London, Maryland, and Mississippi. He has distinguished himself as a teacher of medicinal chemistry and a researcher in synthetic heterosteroids. He has been a member of the Committee of the International Union of Pure & Applied Chemistry and Pharmacy Council of India. He has over two hundred research, review and professional publications to his credit. He has

coauthored a monograph on Medicinal Chemistry Research in India, and four texts in pharmaceutical chemistry. He has coauthored four book chapters in the series *Progress in Medicinal Chemistry*. He is a National Fellow of the University Grants Commission and recipient of coveted Mody Research Award and Ranbaxy Research Award.

For the last many years Dr Singh has activated his lifelong interest in history of pharmacy. He has made a formidable collection of source material which is proving to be a nucleus for national archives in pharmacy.

The *Pharmacopoeias and Formularies* is the first of the treatises, with the others in making, on History of Pharmacy in India and Related Aspects.
